THE BEAUTY OF WINES GROWN IN SAND

Our largest wine region is a special one in many ways. This region has the highest number of sunshine hours in the country, indeed, in general, roots of the vineyards are spreading into the sand here, except for Hajós, where they end in loess. This helped a lot to increase the prestige of the region in the era of phylloxera pandemic in the 19th century, as the pests were unable to survive in the sand, so the vineyards got less exposed here, compared to other areas. Wines in the region are usually made for the moment and not for long maturation, they are lighter, softer and having lower alcohol content than those from the mountain areas. Should it be white, rosé or red, feel free to open a bottle on a common Wednesday evening, it would be an excellent refreshing drink. However, it does not mean that premium category wines are not made in sand.

Local winemakers of the region are proud of their long matured Ezerjó, Rajnai Rizling, Kékfrankos, Kadarka or Cabernet wines.

WHERE THE SKY MEETS THE EARTH

A place where the horizon stretches from Danube to Tisza; where even a small hillock looks almost like a mountain; where hot air vibrates in summer and frost creaks in winter; where once wild horses roamed freely through the wind and local people travelled in bullock carts; where the sand dunes are flown by wind like in an African desert; where lakes are homes of otters and bee-eaters living in loess walls; where notable representatives of the Hungarian literature like Sándor Petőfi, Ferenc Móra or Gyula Juhász were born; where the sun ripens grapes on more than 24,000 hectares, the largest vine-planted area in total in Hungary – this beautiful place is the Danube Wine Region.

WINES OF HUNGARYOHU





Szeged is considered as city of sunshine. Go to see the beautiful tulip trees on Széchenyi Square then continue your walk along the Kárász Street, and have a tasty Szeged-style fish soup in one of the famous taverns, which needs of course a glass of local Siller (a traditional wine type between rosé and red).



Have a light walk within the beautifully renovated old cellars carved into the loess in the Hajós Cellar Village, look at the old Kadarka plantations on the Kolostor Hill, then have a wine tasting by appointment at one of the cellars.



Go to Pörböly, take the narrow-gauge forest railway then have a guided tour in Gemenc, one of the largest floodplain forests in Hungary. Head off to Baja in the evening. Have a bowl of famous Baja-style fish soup with match-stick noodles accompanied by a local wine from Hajós Wine District.



Visit the birth house of the legendary poet, Sándor Petőfi in Kiskőrös, then have a pleasant splash in Lake Vadkert. After swimming, a glass of cool Generosa or Kövidinka will be extremely refreshing.



Visit the Shepherd's Museum in Bugac, take a walk in the Primeval Juniper Grove, then taste one of the traditional dishes of the Great Plain and drink some wine from Kunság Wine District.


