A place where the river Bodrog runs into the Tisza, and the water world of the floodplain area promises exciting adventures; where the rising sun paints the morning mist pink and a boat gliding on the water fades away into the twilight; where the 9 million years ago extinct volcanoes created such diverse rocks here that one finds even up to thirty-five different soil layers in a single plot; where the love of grape and wine passes down from father to son; where ruins of synagogues are protected by villages, and grand rabbis are buried; where the ancient castles still keep secret conspiracies, and the old-established cellars evoke the memories of great wines; where the unique natural sweet wine, that the whole world knows as simple as "Tokaji", is a common treasure of all people – this 5,700 hectares of land being the most famous wine-growing area of Hungary, is the Tokaj Wine Region.

TOKAJ, THE WONDER OF NATURE

It is hard to talk about the region and the Tokaj wines without getting emotional. This area is not simply a wine region for us, it is part of our national identity. The first written record on vineyards in Tokaj dates back to 1252. Tokaj is still a demarcated wine district, where the two most important grape varieties out of the six permitted ones are Furmint and Hárslevelű. Since the early 2000s, these two varieties have also been used to make high-quality, full-bodied dry wines here, which faithfully reflect the distinctive taste of the volcanic terroir. Our world-famous Tokaj wine specialty, the Tokaji Aszú, was first mentioned in 1571, making it evident that the greatest treasure of the region is almost 500 years old. It was well recognized and appreciated since ever, it is said that French king, Louis XIV referred to it as "Wine of Kings, King of Wines", indeed, Mozart and Goethe were also keen admirers of it. What exactly is this wine, Tokaji Aszú? It is one of the richest, most valuable natural sweet wines in the world, whose production requires specific climatic conditions.

5 UNMISSABLE EXPERIENCES

1.

Have a lovely day on the northern edge of the Tokaj Wine Region. Spend some time at the Museum of the Hungarian Language in Széphalom, visit the castle and the Library of the Reformed College in Sárospatak, and finally enjoy some local wines in one of the cellars at Herceghút.

2.

Discover the medieval castles of the region. The castles of Füzér, Regéc and Boldogkő are really worth a trip on their own as well, but it is even better to end up the tour in one of the settlements in the wine district and relax with a glass of local Furmint or Hárslevelű.

3.

Paddle on the river Bodrog. A guided tour shows you the wonderful wildlife of the area, after that you can tease yourself with a local fried fish in one of the bistros nearby. Finish the day in a cosy cellar and enjoy the winemaker's stories about the wines.

4.

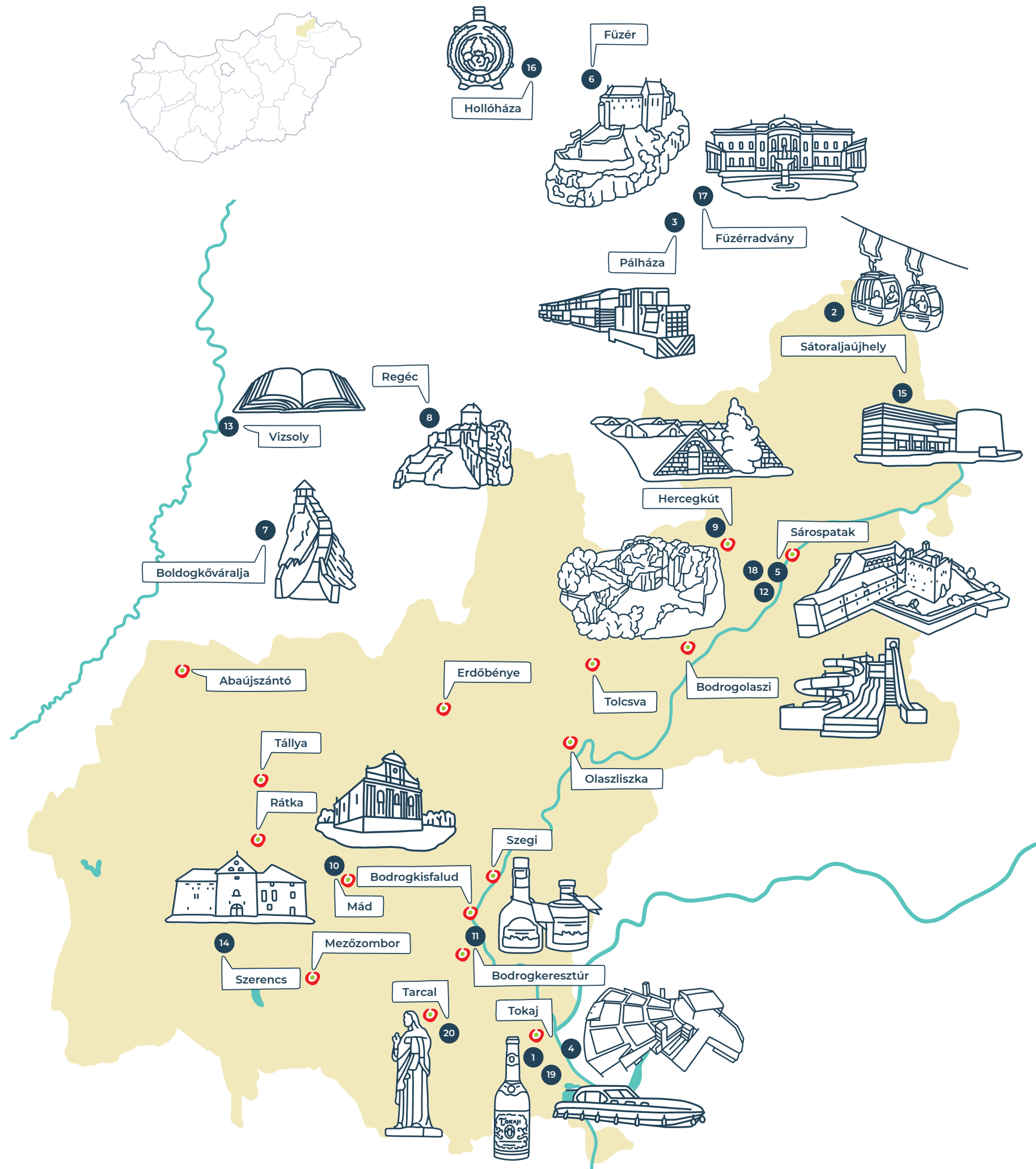
Travel on the oldest forest railway of Hungary. The narrow-gauge railway between Pálháza and Rostalló runs across the untouched nature, this 10 km long trip is really magical. Spend the rest of the day around Tolcsva and Erdőbénye and taste some sweet wines of Tokaj.

5.

Get some adrenaline in the Zemplén Adventure Park in Sátoraljaújhely, then have a traditional Tisza-style fish soup for lunch in one of the taverns in the area. In the afternoon, register for a vineyard tour at one of the wineries in Mád, and then taste the assortment of the cellar including dry wines, Szamorodni (the other flagship wine type of the region) and the Tokaji Aszú itself.
