

REFRESHING BUBBLES, COOL WHITES, ELEGANT REDS

Sopron Wine District was once characterised exclusively by white grapes, however by today, two-thirds of the plantations are black grapes, primarily Kékfrankos, which has become a flagship of the wine district. The area around Pannonhalma has retained its white wine character, its wines are rather full-bodied and tolerate the long maturation due to the terroir endowments. Both in the past and recently, the emblematic grape variety of the Mór Wine District has been the Ezerjó. As a reward of the work of young winemakers, a new style has been introduced recently, and the Mór Wine District is getting to regain its former popularity. The climate of the Neszmély Wine District is mainly favourable for white grape varieties, slopes of the Gerecse Mountains and gentle hillocks alongside the Danube have been planted with Irsai Olivér, Chardonnay and Szürkebarát. Cool microclimate and calcareous soil make Etyek a home of sparkling wines, but Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir grown here also end up in remarkable still wines.

It is always guaranteed to find some good wines and a pleasant wine experience by any cellars in the region.

EMBRACED BY MOUNTAINS AND WATERS

A place where the silver ribbon of the Danube runs respectfully through the country; where we can wave our hands to our Austrian friends from the top of the Írott-kő, the highest peak of Transdanubia; where tiny rippling waves of the Lake Fertő tenderly reflect the sunshine; where the view is dominated by two impressive buildings: the Archabbey of Pannonhalma with its thousand-year history in the west, and the Esztergom Basilica in the east; where you can literally touch the history from castle to castle; where the astonishing water world can be discovered by canoe or kayak; where you can walk miles in underground cellar passages exploring the memories of Hungarian sparkling wine; where the sun ripens grapes on more than 5,500 hectares – this diverse and exciting landscape with its amazing built heritage here is the Upper Pannon Wine Region.

5 UNMISSABLE EXPERIENCES

Go for a bicycle ride from Sopron to Fertőd, and visit the Palace of the ducal Family Esterházy there. Along the way, visit a couple of wineries and taste the elegant Kékfrankos of the area.

Spend a whole day in Pannonhalma, visit the Archabbey, take a lovely walk in the Lavender Garden, and pop in a pleasant winery to try the wine district's excellent Rajnai Rizling by a portion of a 'hemina' – i.e. a traditional daily amount of wine for a Benedictine monk allowed to consume.



Go on a hike in Vértes Mountains, enjoy the view from the beautifully restored castle of Csókakő, then head off to Mór, where local winemakers are eagerly waiting to offer you a glass of Ezerjó.



Have a look behind the scenes at the Korda Studios in Etyek, then ramble around a bit in the very real world of Etyek cellars. Be sure to ask there a sparkling wine, a Sauvignon Blanc and a Pinot Noir to taste.

Go hiking around the Lake of Tata, then jump over to the Neszmély Wine District. The panorama over the Danube is breathtaking from the top of the Meleges Hill. It is the best with a glass of Irsai Olivér in hand, however, a fresh, fruity local Merlot would fit more for the picturesque sunset.
